## **Residential Brush Burning Permit**

**January 15<sup>th</sup> through May 1<sup>st</sup>**

### ***OPEN AIR BURNING REGULATIONS:***

1. You must call the Burning Permit Line at 781-585-0531 *each day you wish to burn* and leave your name, address and permit number. Burning may not start before 10:00 A.M.
2. Burning must be brush **ONLY** and be generated from the location listed on this permit and must be 75 ft. from a dwelling.
3. No burning will be allowed to commence after 2:00 PM and must be totally extinguished by 4:00 P.M. Burning may be suspended earlier due to weather conditions. Fires must be attended at all times.
4. Smoke that constitutes a nuisance/health hazard or poor atmospheric conditions may result in suspension of your privilege to burn.
5. Water, shovels, rakes or similar equipment must be readily available to control burning.
6. This privilege does not release the holder from liability for damages.

### **THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED:**

- **Burning on commercial, business or industrial land or commercial land clearing.**
- **Burning during poor atmospheric ventilation.**
- **Burning on dry, windy days, or burning of grass, leaves, rubbish or building debris.**

*This privilege is granted under the condition that the person conducting the burning is the property owner or his/her designee and such burning will be done within the hours and regulations set forth above.*

*Violation of any part of these regulations will result in immediate revocation of your permit.*
